

RULE CHANGES



YELLOW: CAUTION. WHEN A YELLOW FLAG IS DISPLAYED, COMPETITORS MUST RIDE CAUTIOUSLY UNTIL THEY HAVE PASSED THE INCIDENT THAT CAUSED THE FLAG. WHEN DISPLAYED THERE IS NO PASSING OR GAINING AN ADVANTAGE AND JUMPS MUST BE ROLLED BETWEEN THE FLAG AND THE INCIDENT THAT CAUSED THE YELLOW FLAG.

FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF FIVE POSITIONS OR DISQUALIFICATION, SUBJECT TO THE REFEREE'S DISCRETION.



WHITE WITH RED CROSS: INDICATES THAT AMBULANCES, SAFETY VEHICLES, OR EMERGENCY PERSONNEL MAY BE ON THE COURSE.


COMPETITORS MUST RIDE WITH EXTREME CAUTION UNTIL THEY HAVE PASSED THE INCIDENT THAT CAUSED THE FLAG. WHEN DISPLAYED, THERE IS NO PASSING OR GAINING AN ADVANTAGE AND JUMPS MUST BE ROLLED BETWEEN THE FLAG AND THE INCIDENT THAT CAUSED THE RED CROSS FLAG.

FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF TEN POSITIONS OR A DISQUALIFICATION, SUBJECT TO THE REFEREE'S DISCRETION.

NEW PROTECTION STANDARD

PER SECTION 1.2.F(4)

IT IS MANDATORY THAT CHEST AND BACK PROTECTION BE WORN BY ALL COMPETITORS. THE PROTECTOR MAY BE WORN UNDER OR OVER THE JERSEY, AND IT SHOULD COVER THE STERNUM, ANTERIOR RIBS, POSTERIOR RIBS, AND SPINE FROM T1 TO T12.

BIG BIKE BEGINNER CLASS! THIS CLASS DOESN'T EARN POINTS, AND RIDERS IN THIS CLASS CAN NOT SIGN UP FOR ANY OTHER CLASSES.
