The Pueblo facility once again delivered a fast, technical layout racers have come to expect from Honor Farm. Riders faced deep ruts, rough braking bumps, and challenging corners that evolved throughout the day. Competition was intense in several classes.

In Open Pro A, Bronson McClure captured the overall with consistent 1-1 moto finishes, edging out Carson Roberson, Jorge Rubalcava, and Jeremiah Willoughby who kept the pressure on all day.

Deegan Miller and Cole Massa battled in Schoolboy 1 with Miller taking the overall after rebounding from second place in Moto 1 to take the win in Moto 2. Luke Carns swept both motos in Schoolboy 2, with Jayden Smedley and Tanner Pike rounding out the podium. In the Micro Jr Limited 4-6 race, Wyatt Otto finished strong with 1-1 moto finishes, with Schuyler Totten and Colden Pepler not far behind.

Each class winner also received a special Austin Schindler Memorial Award, which has become a tradition at every Honor Farm race! Racing aside. Dodgeball was a hit (pun intended). The dodgeball tourney was back and in full force Saturday after practice! Lots of smiles and good times were had. Do not miss the next battle at Honor Farm MX. 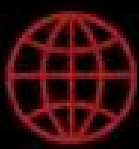

Massa had a great day going 1-1 in all his classes; Sr mini 85's, Supermini, and Schoolboy 1. The Schoolboy 1 races was great racing between Massa and number 134 of Deegan Miller on his Yamaha.



Another rider that had a dominant day was number 352 Bronson McClure on his G-Force Race Team Yamaha. McClure's smooth riding style lead to his 1-1 in 450A and 2-1 in Open Pro A. Seen left is McClure airborne with Pikes Peak visible in the background.

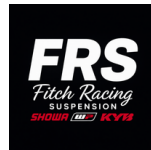
